1. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- In coordination with the ND-JOC, Soldier selected will assist executing command and control over wildland fire preparations, mission execution, and recovery.
- Serve as liaison between ND-JOC and North Dakota Forest Service (NDFS).
- Review & amend the NDNG wildland fire fighting standard operating policies and procedures
- Coordinate and assist scheduled Red Card Training Certification Course alongside the NDFS and other state agencies
- Lead the inspection and inventory of wildland firefighting equipment
- Other duties as assigned.

- Must be a current member of the North Dakota Army National Guard (NDARNG).
- Ability to travel in region of responsibility.
- Knowledge of applicable military regulations, policies, and directives
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively.
